The documentary tracks the initiative's steps from training a core team of peer educators and actors to developing awareness plays on youth related health topics with high school students. A documentary about diversity and diversity management regarding youth from different social, political and cultural backgrounds. They share experiences in each of their communities as main actors of change through the political youth development and community youth development. Duration: 20 min

My Lebanon Project @ 1:45 pm

"My Nationality is a Right for Me and My Family" campaign tries to put women's-basic-right-to-nationality under the spot light; Its major goal is to amend the nationality code in Lebanon as well as in other Arab countries. Duration: 14 min



Maid in Lebanon @ 2:00 pm

Tracing women's journeys from Sri Lanka to Lebanon, this film exposes the little known world of the domestic migrant worker. While some are able to succeed, many do not. In their own voices, the women in this film reveal cases of torture, rape, physical and mental abuse, and non-payment of wages. The documentary explores the questions of why women migrate, why they often return to the Middle East multiple times, and why abuses occur. Duration: 26 min



About Latifa and Others @ 2:30 pm

Latifah Kassir was killed. Her death was not the most tragic part of her story. At the beginning, ten years of marriage to an abusive husband, and later a traumatizing divorce process that left her and her two children at the mercy of a violent drug addict, unjust laws and an alienating society. On a sunny April morning in 2010, her ex, Ibrahim strangled her to death with a towel in her house. It was her children, who discovered her a few hours later, when they came home from school. It is this story, and that of two other female victims of abuse that About Latifa and Others tells. Duration: 30 min
