



Mosè Ricci (Florence, 1956) -Emeritus of Italian Art and Culture since 2003- is Full Professor of Urbanism at the University of Genoa and of Landscape Architecture at the University of Trento. *He graduated in architecture in 1982 at La Sapienza University of Rome (Italy).*

Since 1999 he is member of the Scientific Board of the *Villard* International Seminar and since 2004 of the *Villard* International Doctorate. He has been member of Italian Society of Urban Planners Steering Committee (2003-05, 2007-11). Since 2010 he is member of the *Mies Foundation Mediterranean Program* Board.

He was member of the Scientific Committee and curator of the *Urbanism and Landscape* section of the international exhibition *Recycle, Strategies for Architecture, Cities and Planet* (MAXXI, 2010-12). In 2012 he has been ranked in the *top 100 World Educators* by the Cambridge Institute.

He gave lectures or was keynote speaker in several universities such as: Leibnitz University Hannover (2013); OSU Columbus Ohio (2013); GSD, Harvard University, (2013,1997); Tulane, New Orleans, (2013); KSU (Cleveland, 2011-2010), ETSAB (Barcelona, 2010); TU Munich, (2010-11), Kionggi, Seoul (2009); University of Sao Paulo (2008); UM, Montreal (2005); School of Environmental Design, Waterloo (1996-97); BTU Cottbus, (2000); Weissensee Berlin (2001).

His practice work with RICCISPAINI firm has been included in numerous exhibitions such as the Venice Biennale; MAXXI, Rome; Modern Art Gallery, Rome; and Heimatt Museum, Charlottenburg, Berlin. Editor of *BABEL* international series of books (2000-013 Meltemi and ListLab Publishers). He is author of several books and articles and books such as *New Paradigms* (List Lab, Barcelona, 2012); *UniverCity* (List, Barcelona, 2010); *iSpace* (Meltemi, Rome, 2008); *Rischiopaesaggio* (Meltemi, Rome, 2003).
