



ANTONIO ORTIZ

Antonio Ortiz is an architect by the School of Architecture of Madrid since 1971. He has been a visiting professor at the Lausanne and Zurich polytechnics as well as in Harvard, Cornell and Columbia universities as well as in the School of Architecture of Pampiona. He has held the Keruo Tange Professorship at Harvard's G.S.D. and since 2004 has been an honorary professor at the University of Seville and occupied the Cátedra Blanca at the School of Architecture (Pampiona).

Together with Antonio Cruz, he started his professional activity in 1971. Some of his better-known projects and works are the remodelation of the Bijkinsuseum in Americani, the Sanish Parlion at the Hanover 2000 Exp., he Cartaigs Stadium in Seville, the addition to the SBB Railway Station in Basel, Seville's Public Library, the Stadium of the Community of Madrid, the Haelva Bus Station, Santa Justa Railway Station in Seville, and bousing building in Dolta Maria Cornol Street.

Lately, in 1997 they were awarded the Gold Medal of Andalusia for their professional career. They have also obtained the Premio Andalusia de Arquitectura 2008 for the Basel Railway Station and the International Spanish Architecture Award for the Rijkinsuruseum in 2018.

Cruz and Chtt's work has been widely reviewed in the main specialized publications and several monographs about it have been published (Tanais, Princeton Architectural Press, Birkhauser, AV, T. Cuadernov, NAI publishers and Guszuro Gill, in addition, enhibitions about their work have taken place in Zurich (E.T.H.), Berne (Anthaus), Lusanne (EPTI, Botzano (Ordine degil Architetti), Botson (Harvard, Graduste School of Design), Berlin (Aedes East Galler), Amsterdam (Amsterdam Publis Library) and Serial and Granada (Andaluxian rerional Government).
